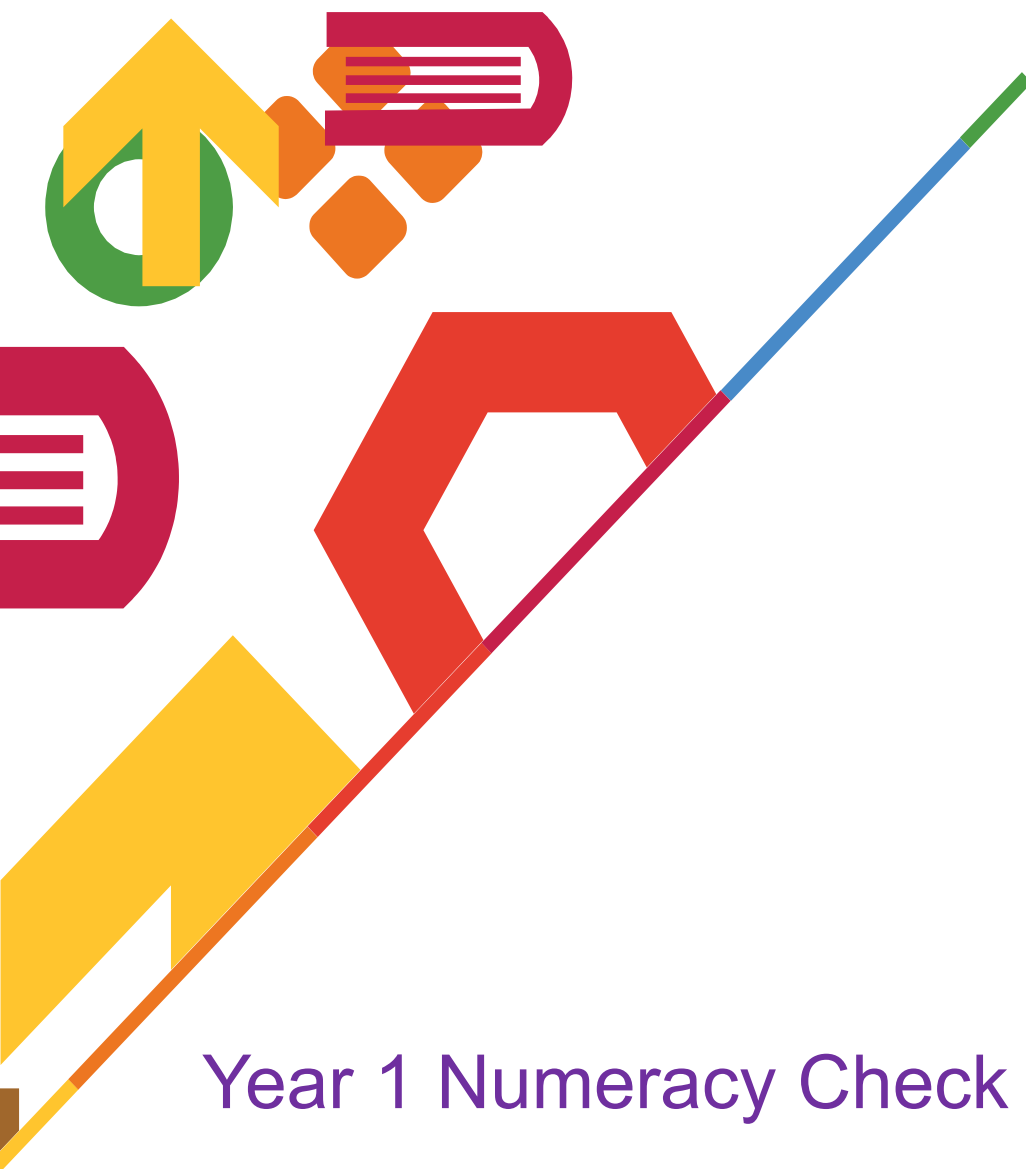

Script

Year 1 Numeracy Check - Practice Section demonstration_SCRIPT

This document contains the script for teachers to follow and read aloud if demonstrating the Year 1 Numeracy Check Practice Section to their class, themselves (as opposed to playing the pre-recorded video demonstration).

Notes to the teacher have been provided in *italics* in addition to the scripted text.

****NOTE TO TEACHER:** *prior to commencing this demonstration, prepare the practice section preview, ready to share on screen*

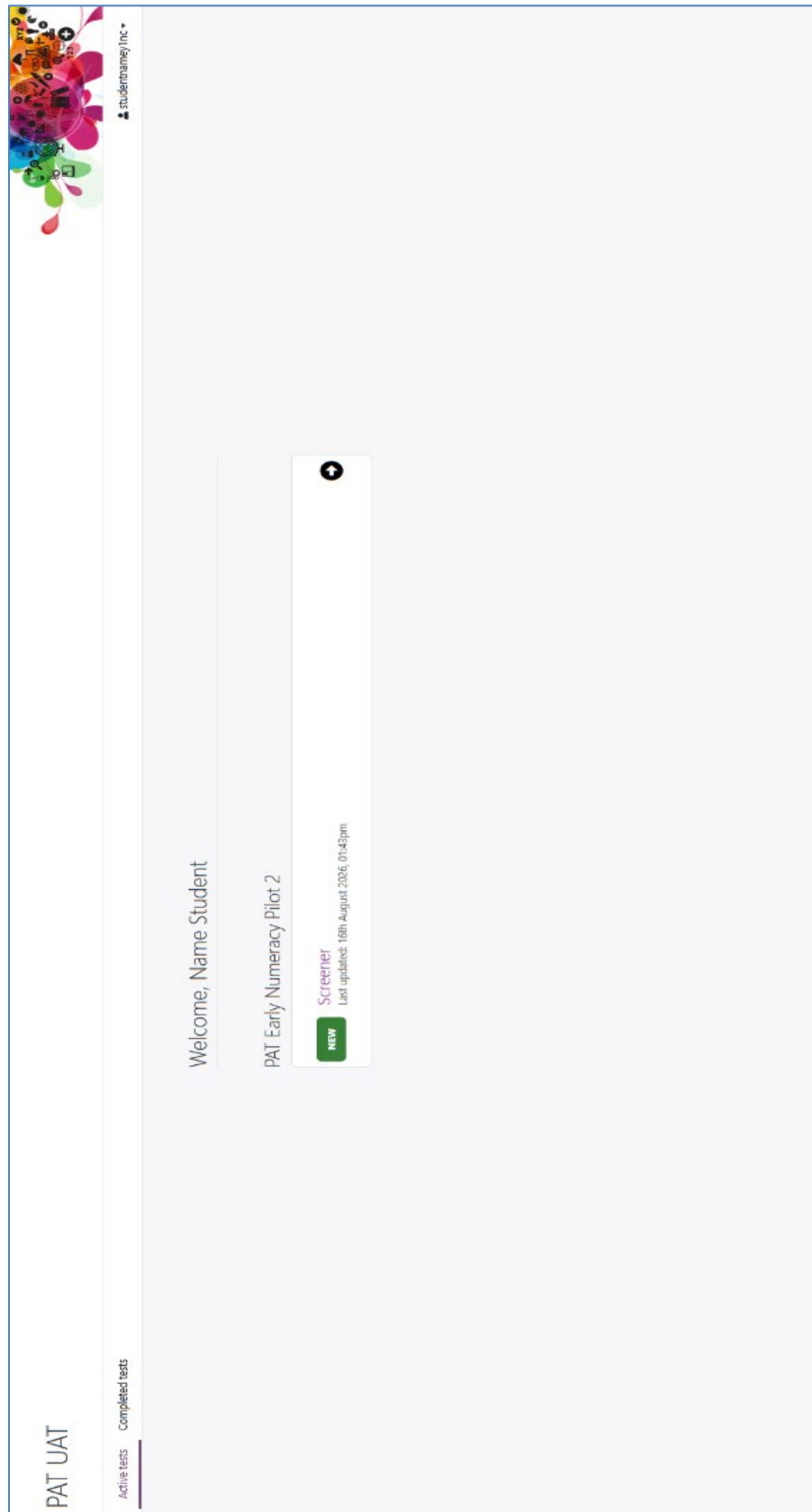
1. *Log in to your OARS account*
2. *Go to the STUDENTS page*
3. *Click the TESTS button*
4. *Select PREVIEW*
5. *Select test: select **PAT Early Numeracy Pilot 2***
6. *Select form: select **Practice** (do NOT select Screener)*

Hello students.

One day in the next few weeks, you will be completing an online maths test in the classroom. We want to make sure that you know what to expect, so today, I will show you what the maths test looks like.

When it's time for you to complete your maths test, you will see a screen that looks like this on your device.

****NOTE TO TEACHER:** *you will not be able to show students this image on screen as it will only be available to students once the Year 1 Numeracy Check has been assigned to them. ACER suggests you show them the printed image on your script*



You will see your name and the name of your maths test on the screen. It's important you wait for your teacher's instructions before you click anything else.

When your teacher asks you, you'll need to tap on the word 'Screener' to open your test. Depending on which device you use to complete your test, you might need to **tap** on the screen or **click** on the word, using the mouse or trackpad.

**** NOTE TO TEACHER:** *Now you may share your screen with the students (Preview of Practice test)*



On the next screen, you will see your name at the top of the screen.

When your teacher asks you to, you will need to put on your headphones and tap the arrow.

After you do this, you will see words on the screen, which will be read aloud to you. Let's tap the arrow and have a look...

****NOTE TO TEACHER:** *Tap the arrow*



Let's practise how the test works.
When I say "tap", touch the screen or click with your mouse.
Now tap the arrow to go to the next screen.




I'll tap the arrow to go to the next screen...

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**

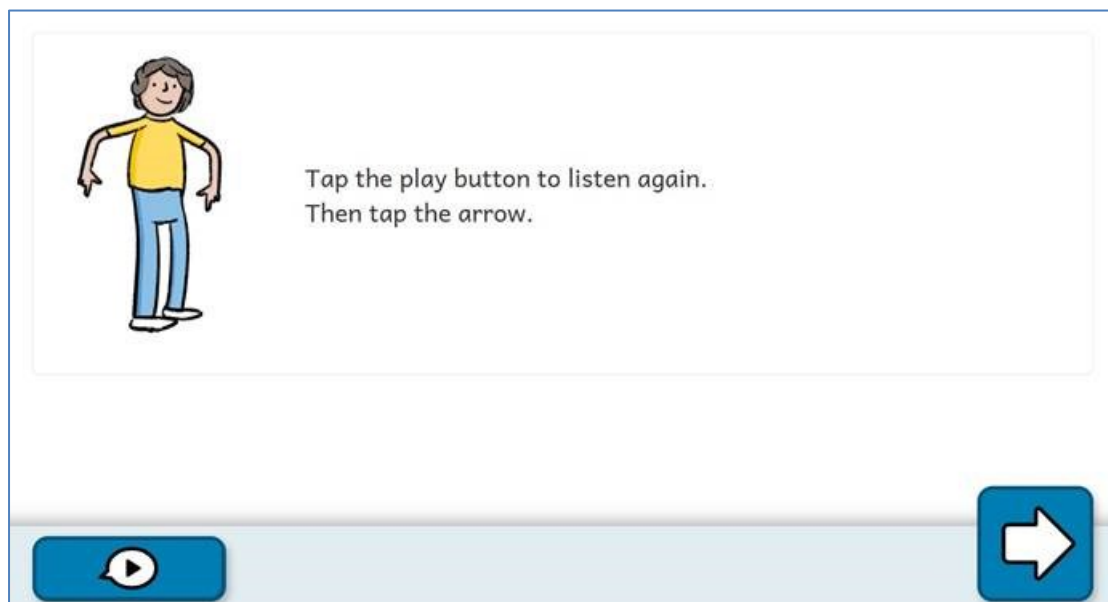


When the play button is pink, listen.
Wait for it to turn blue.
Then tap the arrow.



Now that the play button has turned blue, I can tap the arrow....

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**

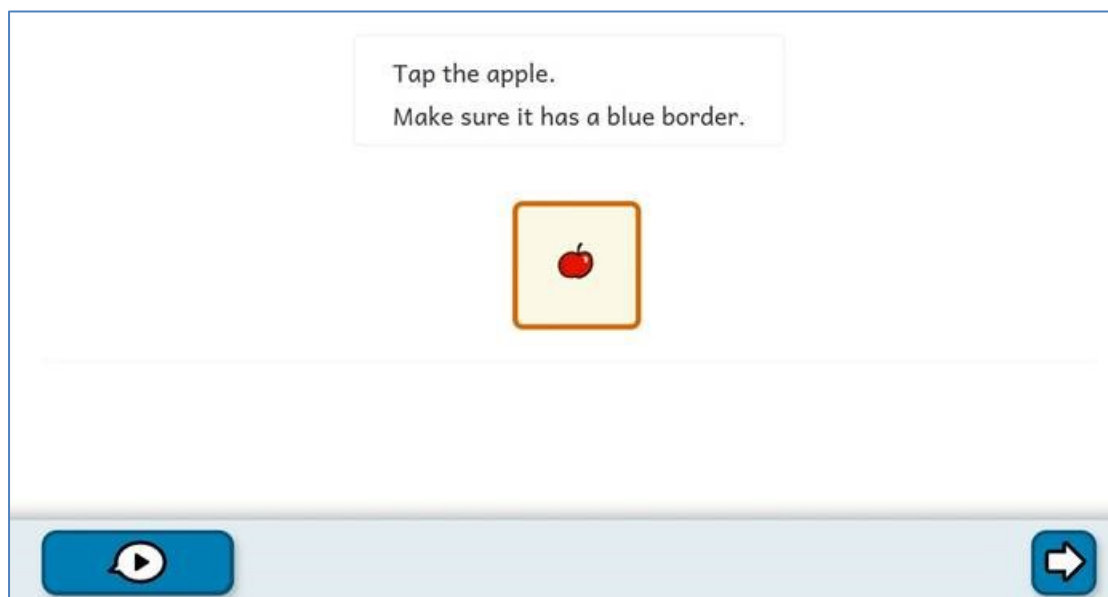


When you complete your maths test, for most questions, you will be able to replay the audio if you need to listen again. For some questions though, the audio **replay** button will disappear if you try to click it. That's just how this activity works — just try your best each time. I'll click the audio button to replay....

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Click the audio button to replay the audio**

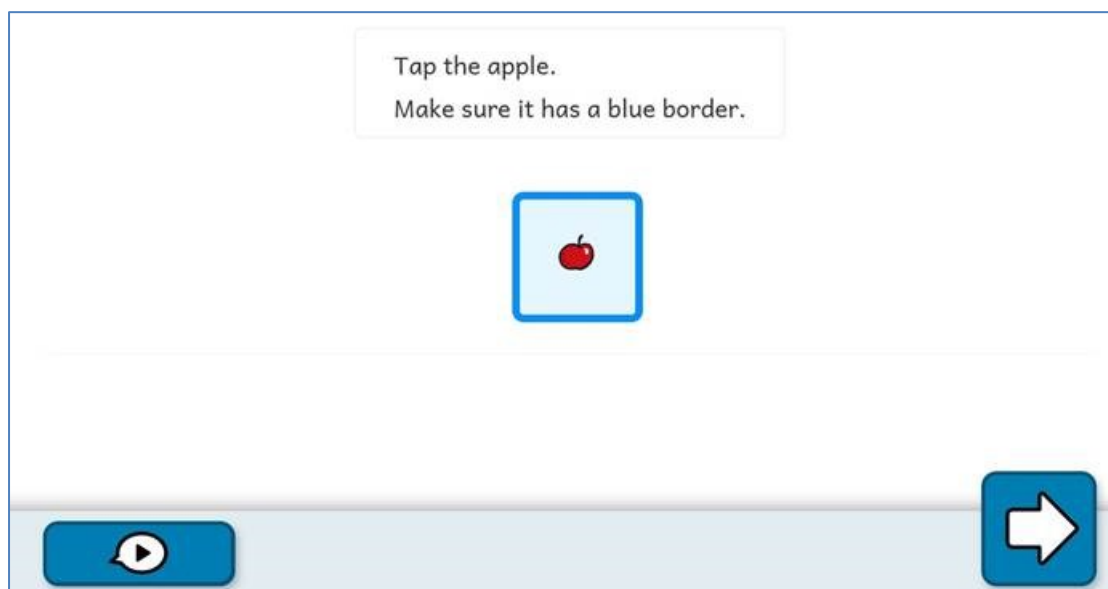
Now I'll tap the arrow...

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**



In your maths test, you will be asked to tap on things that appear on screen.
We can see that the apple has an **orange** border. Watch what happens when I tap it...

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the apple**



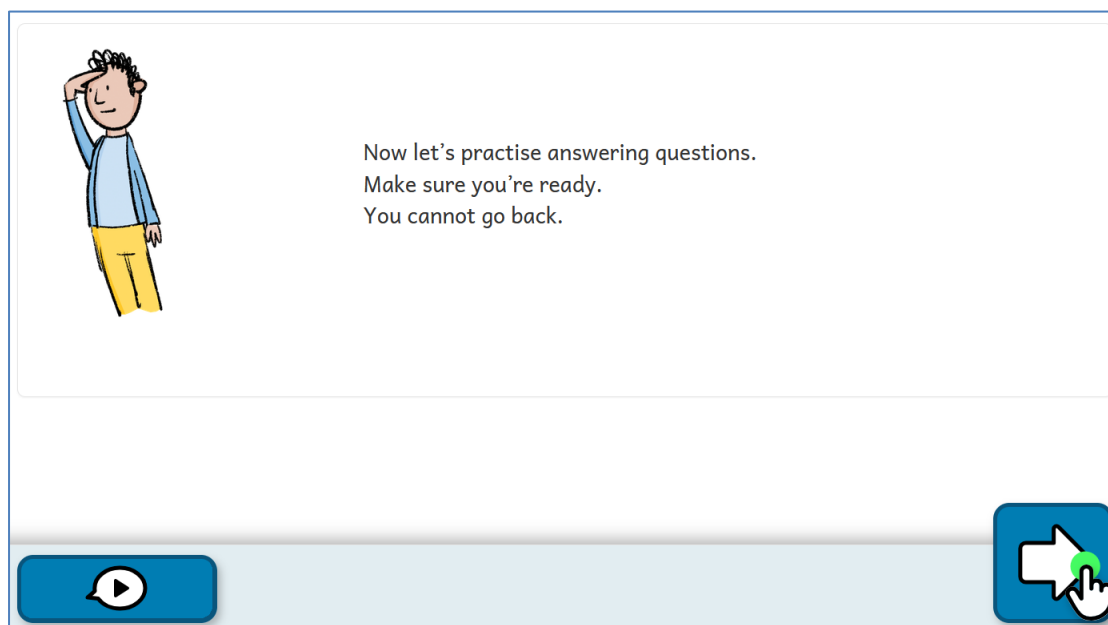
Now the apple has a **blue** border, just like we need it to.
When we see the blue border, we know that we have tapped successfully.

That's the end of my introduction.



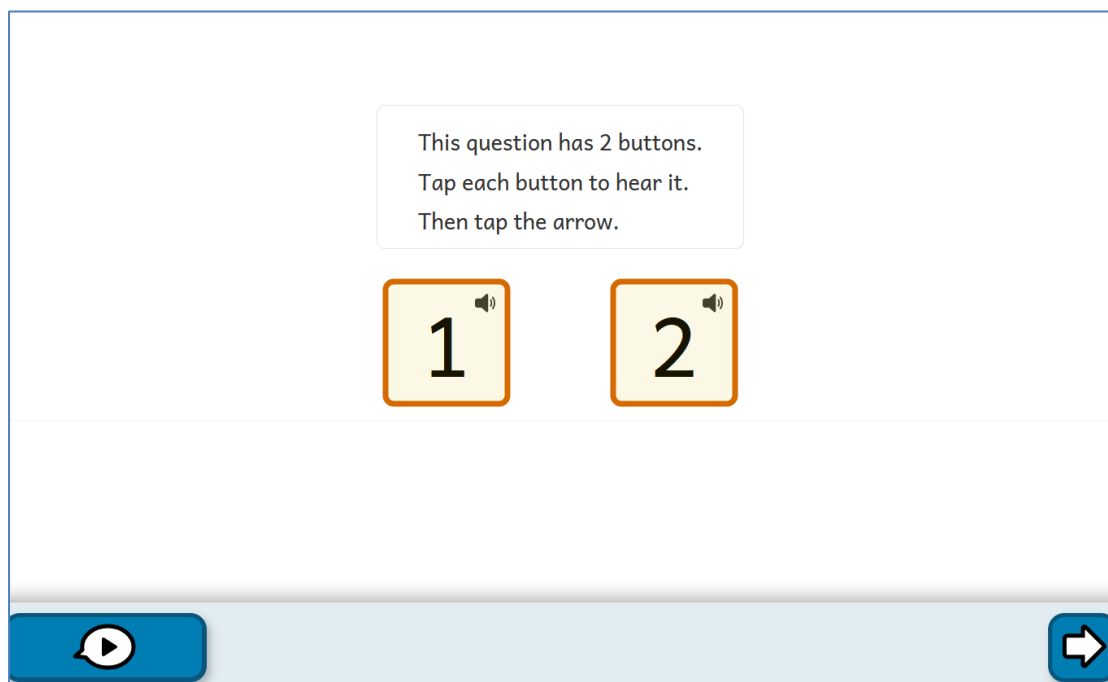
For the rest of this demonstration, I will show you some practice questions.

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**



When you log in to complete your own maths test, you will see these exact same questions that I'm about to show you. They are **practice** questions to help you get used to tapping on the screen of your device OR clicking the mouse. I'll tap the arrow to start...

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**

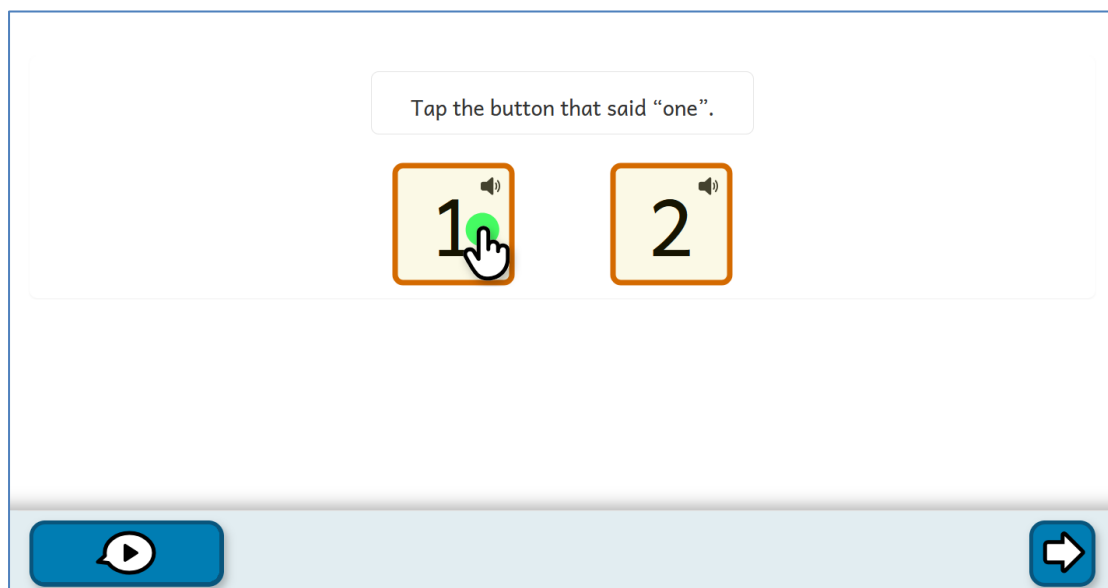


I will tap each button to hear them,

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap "1" and then Tap "2"**

and now I'll tap the arrow.

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**



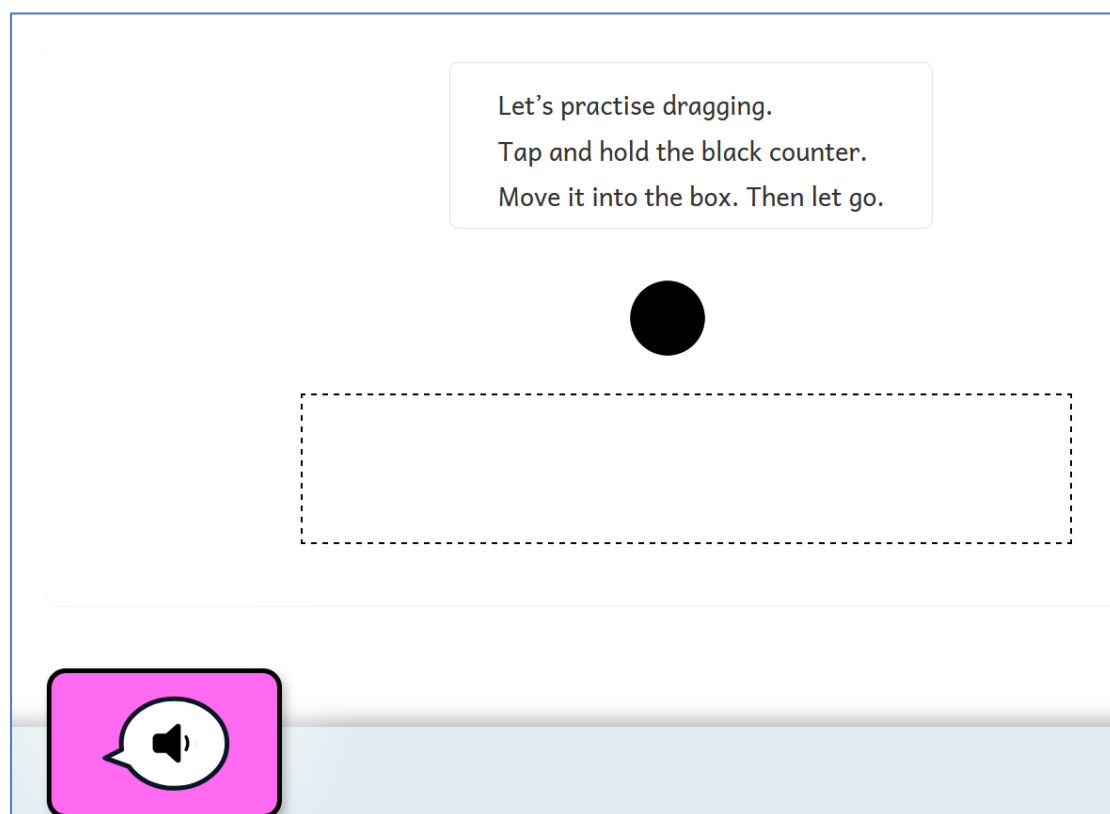
I will now tap the button that says 'one'.

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap "1"**

Notice how the border turned blue? That means I have tapped it successfully.

I will now tap the arrow to move to the next question...

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**



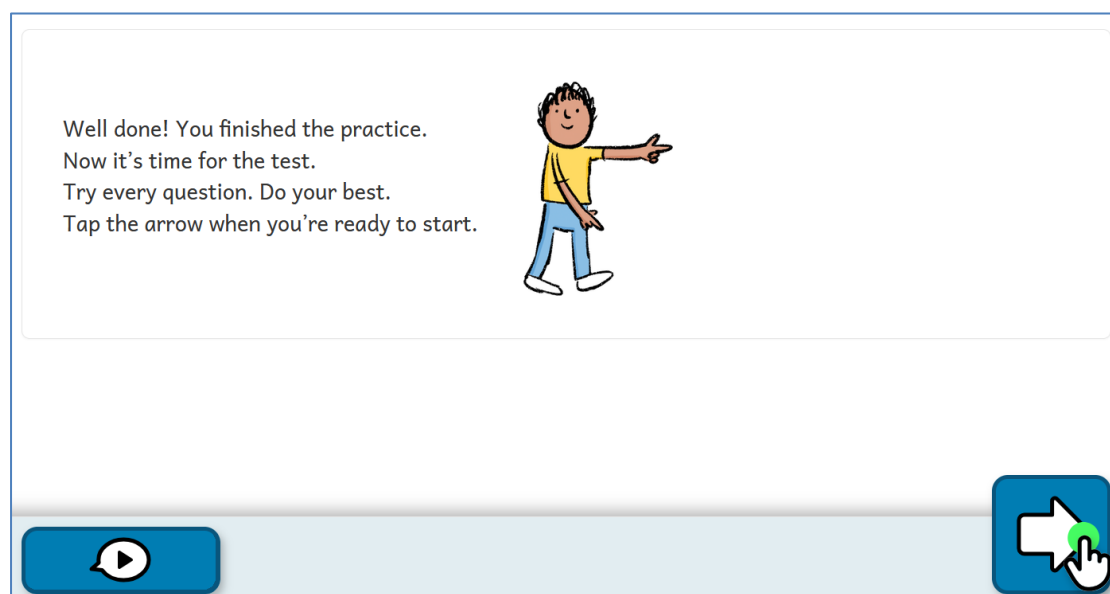
In this question, instead of tapping something, I need to tap, hold and drag the counter into the box.

If I don't drag the counter into the box properly, it flies back to its starting place.

*****NOTE TO TEACHER: Demonstrate dragging the counter to the edge of the box, so that the counter flies back to the starting place***

It's important that you drag the counter into the box properly before tapping the arrow. Just like this.

*****NOTE TO TEACHER: Demonstrate dragging the counter into the box, then tap the arrow***



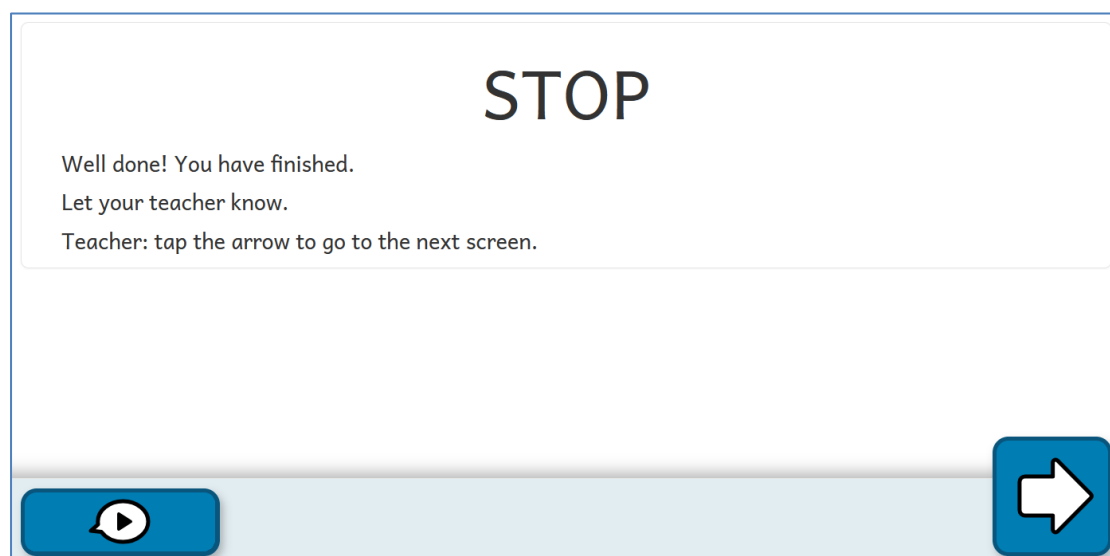
That's the end of the practice questions!

You might have noticed that the arrow button only goes forwards. There is no backwards arrow, so you won't be able to go back. That's ok! That's just how this activity works — you only move forward through the questions. Just try your best each time.

After you click this arrow, you will start your test.

When you get to the end of your test this next screen will appear.

****NOTE TO TEACHER: Tap the arrow**



You do not need to tap anything else – just let your teacher know that you have finished.

Well done. You are now ready to complete your own maths test when your teacher asks you to.
